



ACTION STEP 3: PRAYING SCRIPTURE

Read and pray through Psalm 27, use the Power Promise Presence worksheet as a guide.

→ When we pray scripture, we can trust that we are praying for God's will because it is His own words that we are using.

HOW TO PRAY SCRIPTURE

1. Read the Psalm (27)
 - Read the Psalm
 - Use the Power, Promise, Presence worksheet to guide your time
2. Pray the same words of the Psalmist
 - Example from verse 1:

The Passage:

A Prayer:

The Lord is my light and my salvation— whom shall I fear? The Lord is the stronghold of my life— of whom shall I be afraid?	The Lord is my light and my salvation— whom shall I fear? The Lord is the stronghold of my life— of whom shall I be afraid? Or Lord, thank you that you are my light and my salvation. That because of you I do not have to fear. You are the stronghold of my life, and because that is true, I do not have to fear.

3. Use the Psalm to inform your prayers
 - Example from verse 1

The Passage

A Prayer:

The Lord is my light and my salvation— whom shall I fear? The Lord is the stronghold of my life— of whom shall I be afraid?	Lord, be my light and my salvation through (<i>name your current fears and circumstances</i>). Lord you are the stronghold of my life and (<i>tell the Lord where you need Him to be your strength in this season</i>). Because of you I do not have to fear (<i>name your fears</i>)
